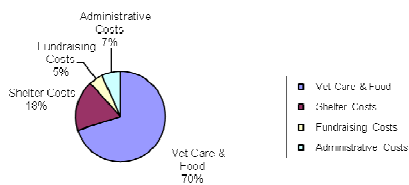
KAS...BY THE NUMBERS

People often ask us... Where does the money come from to operate your shelter? How do you keep it going? Primarily the money comes from fundraising events, such as raffles and yard sales, and from our kind donors, through condo sponsorships, direct donations, special appeals, and more recently, town appropriations. Below we've included a breakdown of expenses and revenues for the year 2014, in an effort to raise awareness of how important your support is to us. As you can see, 88% of our expenditures are for the direct costs of sheltering and caring for the cats (our guests) in our care, and direct public support (individual, business, and town) constitutes 61% of our revenue. As costs continue to rise, we anticipate more effort will be needed to increase the revenues to keep pace. And as always, we are grateful to you all for your continued support of Kingdom Animal Shelter!

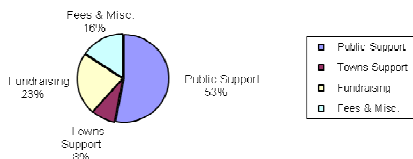
